

## Information on EU mobility

The EU's mobility arrangements enable you to also study in Germany for up to 360 days if you hold a Finnish residence title for study purposes. Your Finnish residence title must be valid for the entire duration of your stay in Germany.

The German higher education institution must submit prior notification of your intended stay to the Federal Office for Migration and Refugees. This notification should be provided as soon as it becomes known that you intend to study in Germany. Full notification absolutely must be received no later than 30 days prior to your entering Germany.

The notification which the relevant higher education institution sends to the Federal Office must comprise the following documents:

- Finnish residence title (issued for study purposes and in accordance with the REST Directive (EU) 2016/801),
- a recognised, valid passport/replacement passport (copy only),
- proof that you are taking part in a programme organised by the EU or other multilateral programme entailing mobility and/or the agreement between the higher education institutions, and
- proof that you can support yourself (incl. proof that you have health insurance).

All documents, with the exception of the passport and the residence title, must be submitted in German.
